General Information for Candidates of the Team:

The Team member has the responsibility to represent the Junior Karate Demo Team and American Kang Duk Won Karate in a very positive way. With this in mind, the following rules have been adopted for the betterment of the Team and Organization.

If you feel that you are not able to follow these rules, then please do not tryout for the team..

The following rules are not all inclusive:

- The appearance that a team member has at the time of their selection for the team is the appearance they will be expected to maintain for the remainder of the Team's season. This includes haircuts, hairstyles, hair color, earrings, tattoos, and anything else that would change the team member's appearance.
- The Team has performance and travel uniforms. The Team will provide the team member with their performance uniform. The team member will have to purchase their travel uniform. The cost of the travel uniform is about \$30.00. This is a white shirt and black wind pants with the logo on them.
- The Team's season begins in September and ends in July. There will be two maybe three demonstrations in the summer. In the beginning, the practices will be on Saturdays, with two-hour practices. After the Team has learned all their routines then the practices will be adjusted to less time.
- A Team member is to conduct himself or herself in a positive mode while working with other team members. No negative talk will be accepted.
- There will be fundraisers that the team will have through out the season, and it is expected that each team member do their best to help.
- The parents are a great help to the team. It is encouraged that parents assist in the Team's endeavors as well. Example: Carwashes, transportation to demos, encouragement of team member to make all demos and practices, etc.

These are not all the conduct rules that the Team will have to adhere to, but it does give you a guideline to follow.
